

TERRORISM LIAISON OFFICER (TLO) REQUIREMENTS

The California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) Supplement to the Federal Program Guidance and Application Kit indicates the following TLO and CAL JRIES requirements:

TLO Requirements:

“In an effort to continue to build towards a comprehensive integrated prevention network of information sharing, all recipients (*including sub-recipients*) of FY11 HSGP funds will be required to designate a trained TLO within their organization. Subgrantees (*Tulare County OES*) must require documentation for their sub-recipients prior to the subaward of HSGP funds, which needs to be available during a monitoring visit.”

TULARE OPERATIONAL AREA REQUIREMENTS

- Tulare County OES must have documentation and contact information for at least one trained TLO in your agency, or your agency will not be eligible to spend HSGP funds. Documentation must show that the TLO has received the basic awareness level training (e.g. training certificate).
 - If your agency is not able to designate a trained TLO from its own staff, a trained TLO may be designated from another agency to serve as your agency’s direct point of contact to report any/all terrorist-related activity. This information must be provided to Tulare County OES.
